Action plan for the academic session (2018-2019)

Academic and Curriculum Aspects:

1. The focal point for the upcoming session is the meticulous adherence to university regulations in the implementation of the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) curriculum.
2. The introduction of new undergraduate program courses in Geography and Physical Education for the academic session 2017-18, accommodating 30-60 students in each department.
3. The establishment of a new, consistently updated college website is imperative.
4. Enhancing students' academic pursuits through seminars, field visits, and project work is a priority.
5. The initiation of faculty exchanges between departments, both intra-college and beyond, aims to enrich the academic environment.
6. Amplifying the frequency of parent-teacher meetings and soliciting feedback from students and guardians is integral to maintaining diligent student monitoring.
7. Completion of the academic and administrative audit process for the year 2018-19 is a requisite.

Infrastructure Aspects:

1. The construction of an administrative block within the college campus is underway.
2. A new toilet block for students is in the process of construction.
3. Renovation of existing toilets in the teachers' room and for students is scheduled.
4. Construction of ramps to facilitate accessibility for differently abled students is on the agenda.
5. Campus beautification efforts are in progress.
6. Koha Software installation will grant students and teachers access to library resources.
