I also take keen interest in comparative democratization among Post-Soviet states in order to problematize the notion beyond the Anglo-Saxon domination of our understanding of concepts such as- democratization, democracy, democratic transition and democratic consolidation etc. Also, the countries' engagement with the outside world in an era of globalization with Russia being the largest successor state of the erstwhile Soviet Union, how does Russia position itself vis-à-vis the Western world? It was during this period the issue of Western democracy promotion agenda finds traction. The issue of Foreign Policy of different Post-Soviet states and their different trajectories are of great interest to me.

# Roles and Responsibilities:-

- Prepared a detailed questionnaire (structured method) and conducted interviews of the people living in the locality. Collected relevant data and information pertaining to the topic and submitted a research report in the class by using qualitative as well as quantitative methods.
- The locality which was chosen for the Field Survey is a place of migrated people who have settled there from far off places for livelihoods and other socio economic reasons. In this regard an attempt was made to analyse the settlement issue and the complexities associated with migration and with the migrated population, the cultural interaction and assimilation of the migrated people with the local people by conducting interviews of the local inhabitants of their views about migrated people besides interview being done of the migrated people.
- An endeavour was made to gauge the role of the state and how state perceives the migrated population in the view of ensuring welfare schemes and government assistance to them as the migrated population was found to be largely penurious and illiterate.
